| Speech and Language Therapy | 18 pupils | £18,000 36 x £500 | Targeted intervention receiving at least 1 session per week as part of a small group or 1:1 and benefitting from a wider approach. All pupils had individual communication profiles and were tested/retested. Data is used to inform planning, highlight areas for intervention and to develop classroom practice. Individual progress in targeted areas is evident and whole school impact was positive. Individual and whole school reports |
| Outdoor Education | 12 pupils | £3600 20 x £180 | Offsite intervention that supported our engagement, personal development and rewards systems for targeted groups (2 x 6 pupils). |
| Swimming | 16 pupils | £900 12 x £75 | To support our approach to engagement, personal development and personal safety. 2 groups of 8 pupils learnt to swim - use of pool and instructor. |

All pupils in receipt of PPG benefited from at least 2 of the above areas.
